

Terms and Conditions

The Parent's Authority: The parent/s authorise the Coaches while in loco parentis to take and/or to authorise in good faith all decisions that safeguard and promote the welfare of the Camp attendee. The Parent/s consent to such physical contact with the Camp attendee as may be lawful, appropriate and proper for coaching and to provide comfort to the Pupil if in distress or to maintain safety and good order. The Parent/s consent also to medical treatment, including general anaesthetic and operation under NHS or at a private hospital, when a doctor certifies this is necessary for the welfare of the Camp attendee and if the Parent/s or Guardian/s cannot be contacted in time.

Conduct at Glenalmond: We attach importance to courtesy, manners and good discipline. The coaches are responsible for the care and good discipline of camp attendees while they are on the Glenalmond Campus (and not under control of the Parent or Guardian). The Parent/s however authorise the use of such physical restraint and encouragement for the pupil as may be legal, appropriate and proper in any particular circumstances to maintain good discipline and good order. It is a condition of remaining on the Camp that the Parent/s and the camp attendee accept Camp regime, the maintenance of good order and discipline and courtesy towards the Coaches and fellow attendees that apply at any time. Should a camp attendee be removed from the Camp due to unacceptable behaviour or a significant breach of conduct, the Parent/s accept that no refund will be due.

Injury and Insurance: The Parent/s accept that no claim may be made against the coaches or Glenalmond College for the injury or loss unless this specifically results from an act of omission or negligence on the part of the Coach or School. It is recommended that the Parent/s ensure that they take out personal injury and third party liability insurance on behalf of the Camp attendee.

Photographs and Imagery: The Parent/s authorise Glenalmond College/Coaches to use any photography or imagery of Camp participants for use in any publication, website, advertisement or promotional article in the news media.

Players: All players, including goalkeepers, must provide their own equipment which must be adequate and safe as appropriate including mouth guards and shin pads.

Withdrawal: The Parent/s accept that the withdrawal of individuals from the Camp will not result in a refund being given unless the place can be filled.
