



Bring your own device policy

This policy supports learning by allowing pupils to bring their own personal device to Glenalmond College for educational use. Our goal is to enhance learning while keeping everyone safe and focused.

The College operates a 'Bring Your Own Device' policy and pupils are expected to attend school with an unrestricted Wi-Fi enabled device. Details below:

- Chromebooks and laptops are suitable;
- Devices must have up-to-date antivirus protection;
- Fully charged before school, a spare charger is recommended;
- A case to protect the device is also recommended;
- Devices should be free from parental controls & VPNs to operate on the College's Wi-Fi.

Rules and Responsibilities

Pupils must

- Connect to the College Wi-Fi (no mobile data use);

- Use devices respectfully, responsibly, and quietly;
- Not take photos, videos or recordings without permission;
- Not access or share inappropriate content.
